All schools and Ofsted-registered Early Years providers must follow the Early Years Foundation Stage statutory framework, this sets the standards that all Early Years providers must meet to ensure that children learn and develop well and are kept healthy and safe. It promotes teaching and learning to ensure children's 'school readiness' and gives children the broad range of knowledge and skills that provide the right foundation for good future progress through school and life.

At Manor Hill First School Nursery children are at the centre of all we do, we are incredibly proud of our high quality Early Years provision where children have the opportunity to lead their own learning in an inclusive and supportive environment. Our qualified and experienced staff observe the children on a daily basis and use their observations to plan further opportunities for children to help them progress through the Early Years Curriculum in a way which best suits their needs.

Our Governor run setting is open daily during school term time and provides a full and busy play based curriculum for children aged between two and four years old.

Our Bright Beginners room provides a nurturing environment for two year olds where by using stimulating child led activities the children are encouraged and supported to develop their natural interest in becoming independent. Opportunities are available in our indoor and outdoor environments for construction, mark making and messy play and there is a quiet area for sharing stories, songs and rhymes.

Our Early Explorers room provides a welcoming, encouraging environment for two and three year olds providing perfect conditions for children to explore and discover and become happy confident learners. The continuous provision includes small world play, role play, sensory opportunities construction, fine motor and gross motor activities where children have the opportunity to learn through their own experiences and at their own rate.

Our Little Learners environment comprises of a spacious classroom and outdoor area for our three and four year olds. Alongside focused daily Phonics, Numeracy and Literacy activities, staff plan play experiences based on the children's interests. There are a variety of play spaces including, role-play, sand, water, sensory, construction, small world and reading areas. Weekly Forest School sessions in our extensive school grounds are part of our weekly timetable, these are planned by our qualified Forest School Leaders to offer a wealth of outdoor learning opportunities such as den building, climbing and learning how to use tools. This process encourages the development of spatial awareness and gross and fine motor skills. Forest School also provides exposure to manageable risk, which encourages and teaches children how to assess risk.



At Manor Hill First School Nursery we use loose parts in play, these are materials that can be moved, taken apart, lined up, carried and completely redesigned to make something else, providing endless possibilities in their play and supporting children to explore their imaginations and develop their problem solving skills.

The success in our approach to learning is evident as children leave us to continue their educational journey at the expected level of development for their age or higher.

#### Snack

A healthy snack is provided free of charge during each session. We ask that you provide a water bottle each day so that your child is able to access fresh drinking water at any time. Prior to your child starting Nursery you will be asked to inform us about any special dietary requirements, preferences and food allergies that the child has, and any special health requirements

#### Nappy changing

Please provide a supply of nappies and baby wipes for your child to be kept at the setting. Parents will be informed when these need replenishing.

#### Sun cream

During the warmer weather children should arrive at Nursery with suncream applied and provide a bottle for further application if they are in all day.

#### **Uniform**

We request that all children wear the red Manor Hill polo shirt, (which can be purchased from https://www.price-buckland.co.uk) a grey school dress or skirt or black or grey leggings, trousers or jogging bottoms. Many pupils choose to also wear a school jumper or cardigan. They will also require a coat, preferably with a hood, sensible shoes, a sunhat, pair of wellingtons and a puddle suit to wear for forest school. A bag of spare clothing should be left on their peg in case a change is required.



## Session Times and Prices

The sessions provided are set out below. Any funded hours you are eligible for will be offset against these charges.

## **Funding**

#### Two year olds

Eligible children are entitled to 15 hours a week of free education during school term times with a childcare provider of your choice.

#### Three & four year olds

All 3 and 4 year olds in Staffordshire are entitled to free education for 15 hours a week during school term times (NEF Funded).

Working parents of 3 and 4 year old children could receive an additional 15 hours of funded early education a week, on top of the current entitlement of 15 hours for all 3/4 year olds.
