NC objective:	Vocabulary and crucial knowledge:	
<p>To use a range of materials creatively to design and make products.</p> <p>To use drawing, painting and sculpture to develop and share their ideas, experiences and imagination.</p> <p>To develop a wide range of art and design techniques in using colour, pattern, texture, line, shape, form and space.</p>	<p><u>Context of study:</u> Children will remember that an artist is someone who draws or paints pictures or creates sculptures as a job or a hobby. Children will be inspired by Henri Matisse, who in later life began to experiment with cut outs which he arranged into collages. Children will learn that a collage is a piece of art which can be made from different pieces of paper, photos and other materials. Children will know how to draw different types of lines, straight and curved. Children will know how to make shapes by enclosing spaces with lines. Children will learn how to cut straight and curved lines to make shape cut outs. Children will recap the primary colours and learn how to mix these to create the secondary colours. Children will apply their knowledge of straight and curved lines to make shape cut outs to create their own artwork based on Henri Matisse's Two Masks (The Tomato).</p>	

To learn about the work of a range of artists, craft makers and designers, describing the differences and similarities between different practices and disciplines, and making links to their own work.



Crucial Knowledge:

To know that **Henri Matisse** was an **artist** who in later life began to experiment with cut outs which he arranged into collages.

To know that a **collage** is a piece of art which can be made from different pieces of paper, photos and other materials.

To know that collage artists spend time **arranging** the materials and **trying out** different ideas, before **sticking** them onto a surface.

To know when to use **straight** and **curved** lines.

To use straight and curved lines to **enclose spaces** and create shapes.

To learn how to **cut** straight and curved lines out of paper.

To know that the **primary colours** are red, blue and yellow.

To learn how to mix **primary colours** to make **secondary colours**.

To learn that the **secondary colours** are orange, purple and green.

To learn how to **arrange** cut outs by **trying out** different ideas before **sticking** them onto a surface.
